







Glossary of Terms -

AGG = Aggravated as in aggravated assault, meaning a weapon was used  
AO = Arresting officer  
AP = Arrested person  
APDW = Arrest by police officer without warrant  
AUTO ACC = Auto accessories  
BMV = Burglary of a motor vehicle (this is not stealing a car but breaking in and stealing contents)  
COMP = Complainant  
CP = Complainant  
CPW = Carrying a prohibited weapon  
DW = Deadly weapon  
FV or F/V = Family violence  
FLID = Failed to leave ID at scene  
FSRA = Failure to stop and render aid (note that an FLID becomes an FSRA if there are injuries)  
FUSION = DPD's intelligence gathering and analysis unit with connections to most other law enforcement agencies  
HPC = Harassing phone calls  
M/A = Class A Misdemeanor  
M/B = Class B Misdemeanor  
M/C = Class C Misdemeanor  
MIR = Miscellaneous Incident Report, NO OFFENSE  
NFV = Non-family violence, i.e., stranger-on-stranger  
O/T or OT = Out of town  
PES = Physical Evidence Section (aka CSI)  
RO = Reporting officer  
RP = Reporting person  
TCB = Time Call Began - when the officer started making the actual report  
TCE = Time Call Ended - when the officer finished the report and left the scene  
UCR = Uniform Crime Reporting (FBI)  
UUMV = Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle (stolen car)
